



## Cosy and Cool

The "cosy and refreshingly cool" 161-ft Destination *FOXHARB'R Too* is the latest launch to come from Trinity Yachts. The tri-deck motor yacht had a brief christening ceremony watched over by her new owner, before her aluminium semi-displacement hull and aluminium superstructure hit the water.

Her classification list is as long as my arm (ABS Maltese Cross A-1 Yachting Service, AMS, and MCA Compliant) and her actual 43.1-metre build is impressive in itself.

Both designed and built by Trinity Yachts, she has a smart Patrick Knowles' designed interior that resembles a European Spa Resort, which comprises tailored sophisticated fabrics, stonework showcasing Beaumaniere limestone, River Rock Pebbles and

Walnut and Honduran mahogany. A specific design feature includes a stunning mural on the forward bulkhead of the dining room, that provides a dramatic backdrop for the otherwise serene décor.

The owner has a split-level suite, which offers views of 180 degrees, and his 12 guests can live in luxury in their six staterooms whilst being looked after by the 12 crew members. Her top speed of 20 knots is down to the two Caterpillar 3512B engines, producing 2,250 hp, with a cruising range of 3,000 nautical miles at 10 knots. Furthermore, an advanced stabilising system that features two Quantum active fins with digital controls and Zero Speed makes the journey aboard the Destination *FOXHARB'R Too* a pleasant one.
